Question 13: Loss or Shortage of Funds or Assets: Description: A Union CD valued at \$201,367.85 at Bank of the West was not transferred during the system conversion over Labor Day weekend, September 15, 2023, following its acquisition by BMO. This led to the account's closure and transfer of funds to Colorado's Unclaimed Property Division in 2023. Discovery: Discovered in early 2024, due to the timing of the system conversion. Action: Claim approved; awaiting return of funds. Status: Funds to be returned soon. Preventative Measures: Enhanced monitoring during bank acquisitions and system conversions.
